

HAYLING FERRY BUS CONNECTIONS

From 24th September 2018, for a 6 month trial period, the Hayling Ferry will be linked by bus services both sides of Langstone Harbour.

The bus link on Hayling Island will operate Monday to Friday for the timebeing, and for a limited period at the start of the day and late afternoon, catering for those who normally commute by car.

The 149 Hayling bus is funded by Havant BC, and will be operated by Portsmouth City Coaches Ltd. The service will run from the Hayling Ferry Terminal to Eastoke Corner and then a loop via Rails Lane, Elm Grove, Church Rd, Manor Rd, Beach Rd, then rejoining the seafront at Beachlands, and on back to the Hayling Ferry Terminal.

In Portsmouth, First Bus have extended the existing 15 bus route to the Eastney Ferry Terminal bus stop on Monday to Friday. The 15 route operates between Eastney Point and the City Centre Portsmouth. The existing 15 & 16 service will still continue to operate on Saturday and Sunday from the Fort Cumberland Rd stop.
